# **Auto Sentry – Service Screen**





### Logging In and Accessing the Service Unit Screen

- 1. Open the door with a hex key.
- 2. Press and hold the service switch for a second, and then release. The Service Unit screen appears on the Auto Sentry screen.
- 3. Log in with your 4-digit password, and then tap **Enter**.
- To access the AS terminal, your numerical user password must be set up in WashConnect. Alphanumeric passwords are not accepted at the AS terminal.



### Bill Dispenser, Reset Button, and Coin Hoppers

- The bill dispenser shows the assigned denomination (\$1.00) and the current amount (127) within the dispenser.
- The coin hoppers show the assigned denomination (\$.25) and the current amount (92) within the hopper; (\$1.00) and the current amount (18) within the hopper.
- The token hopper shows the assigned denomination (\$5.00) and the current amount (7) within the dispenser.

Reset button is used to send a reset command to the selected device. Typically, if bill dispenser or coin hopper is jammed.

1. Tap the bill dispenser or coin hopper icon.

Tap the Reset button.
 A reset is sent to the device and "Message Sent To Reset..." appears.



# Bill Acceptor, Coin Acceptor, Commands, Diagnostics, & Close Terminal

- Bill and coin acceptor shows the total amount (top line) and number (bottom line) of bills received.
- Command buttons include Add, Remove, Verify, Start, Stop, and Edit.





#### Close or Open Terminal, Diagnostics, Bump Shift

Tap the **Open Terminal** button when you need to open the terminal. When the terminal is closed, customers cannot purchase washes.

- 1. Tap the **Close Terminal** button. The message "Select device and function to perform" appears.
- 2. After device and function are selected, tap the **Start** button.
- 3. Tap **Exit** to display Wash Closed on the AS terminal.
- 4. Tap the **Open Terminal** button. The Auto Sentry is open.
- 5. Tap the **Diagnostics** button for more advanced dispensing tests, current versions, and alarm reset.



### Keypad, Enter, Exit and Verification Box

- Use the keypad to log in and for numerical input.
- Verification amounts appear in the rectangular Verification
   Box below the Enter and Exit buttons.
- Use the Exit button to exit the Service Unit screen.

### Adding: Bill Dispenser or Coin Hopper

Do this when you need to replenish the cash, coins, or tokens in an AS terminal.

1. On the Service Unit screen, tap an icon.

- 2. Tap **Add**, and then tap **Start**. The instruction box shows a message:
  - Enter total amount (in dollars) you are adding to Dispenser. Tap the ENTER button when finished.
- 3. Enter the amount on the keypad.
  The amount appears in the keypad display.
- 4. Tap **Enter**. The amount is confirmed in the verification box.
  - (Optional) If the amount is incorrect, tap
     Cancel to start over.
- Tap Enter again to confirm.
   The amount is added and the instruction box confirms the transaction. The quantity is displayed on the bill dispenser or coin hopper icon.
- 6. Take the receipt.
- 7. Now remove the bill dispenser or coin hopper.
- 8. Physically add funds, and then replace the device.

# Removing: Bill Dispenser, Bill Acceptor, or Coin Acceptor

Do this when you need to empty a terminal. Use the **Remove** command to empty the entire amount from the device. You cannot remove a partial amount.

1. On the Service Unit screen, tap an icon.

# Acceptor Dispenser Acceptor 2. If the Remove command is not already

- selected, then tap **Remove**.
- 3. Tap **Start**. The instruction box shows the cash drop was accepted and the balance is \$0.00.
- 4. Remove the bill acceptor, bill dispenser or coin acceptor. Physically collect the money, and then replace the device.

### **Verifying: Coin or Token Hopper**

Do this when you need to verify coins from the coin or token hopper.

1. On the service unit screen, select a coin or token hopper icon.



# Coin or Token Hopper

- 2. Have a bag or bucket ready to collect the coins, if necessary.
- 3. Tap **Verify**, and then tap **Start**. The hopper is emptied.
- 4. Tap **Stop** when the hopper is empty.
- 5. Count the number of coins.
  - If the amount is correct:
    - Tap Stop. Ending Bank Unchanged appears in the instruction box. No receipt is printed.
  - If the amount is **not** correct:
    - Tap Edit, and then enter the correct amount.
    - Enter the total number of coins, not the dollar amount. The system will calculate the dollar amount for you.
    - Tap **Stop** to finish.
    - The message "Ending bank has been adjusted by..." appears in the instruction box.
    - Take the receipt.
- 6. Replace the coins in the coin or token hopper.

### **Removing: Coin or Token Hopper**

Do this when you need to remove coins or tokens.

- 1. First, verify the number of coins or tokens by following steps 1 through 5 in **Verifying: Coin or Token Hopper**, above. Skip step 6; do not replace the coins.
- 2. Press the same coin hopper or coin token hopper icon you just verified.



### Coin or Token Hopper

- Tap Remove, and then tap Start. A message appears in the information box. For example, 100 coins removed from Hopper 1 (coin value = \$0.25).
- 4. The amount that you first verified is now removed. An entry is made in the software.
